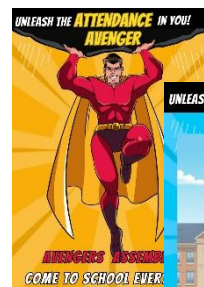
Attendance and Punctuality Trophies - I am pleased to announce the following class winners for our new awards from the end of term 3.
