It is also not beneficial to your child's learning if they are signed out of school early as it can disrupt the classroom programmes and impact on their learning. Please only sign your child out early if you have a genuine reason to, not merely for convenience.

In term 1, 52% of our students attended school for 90% of the time. With the recent amounts of illness in our community this figure is unlikely to have improved. Therefore it is important that children maximise the time at school when they are well, as we do have some concerns for students with frequent absences.

If a child misses 20 days of school a year, by the end of year 12 they will have missed more than a years' worth of schooling!
