Attendance Update - In April 2024 the Government announced a regular attendance target of 80% 0f students to be present for more than 90% of the term by 2030.

In term 1 we had 53% of our students attending for more than 90% of the time with a further 23% attending over 80% of the time. We hope to improve these figures and need your support. If your child is sick please keep them home and notify the school. Sickness is unavoidable and it is better for sick children to recover at home.

If your child is away from school for <u>any</u> reason please contact us and let us know why, as unexplained absences are marked as truant. Please try and schedule holidays and family activities in school break times. If you do need to take your child out of school for travel, a form must be filled out at school with dates, the destination and the reason.
