School Cross Country and Fun Run

This Tuesday 16th March we are having our cross country and fun run events. The cross country races will start at 9.15am and finish at approximately 10.30am according to this schedule. 6 yr old boys, 6 yr old girls, 5 yr old boys, 5 yr old girls, 7-11 yr old girls (optional race for those who wish to run), 7-10 yr old boys (optional race for those who wish to run). The 7-10 yr old races are placed



separately meaning we will have 1st, 2nd and 3rd for each age group the 7, 8, 9, and 10 yr olds. All middle and senior runners are encouraged to bring a change of clothes and appropriate shoes for running (they can also run in bare feet if they wish).
